

Congratulation! You are now a proud owner of Buddyrider.




Read instructions carefully before placing your pet in this seat. Unauthorized modification to the seat could result in serious injury.

Prior to using, check the seat is secure to the bicycle and no parts are cracked, loose, missing, or broken.

Initial rides should be brief, over smooth ground, in a safe location and away from all distractions.

Never leave a pet unattended in this seat. Due to the higher center of gravity, a bicycle may fall over if parked on its stand or without proper support.

Do not allow your pet to become a distraction when riding. Keep your focus on the safe operation of your bicycle, the rules of the road, the environment around you and other cyclists, pedestrians, and vehicular traffic.



Buddyrider Installation steps

Package Contents

- 1 x Buddyrider Seat
- 1 x Support arm
- 1 x Receiver
- 1 x Safety Harness
- 4 x M6 screws with washers
- 5 x M4 screws with washers
- 1 x M6 L shaped hexagon key
- 1 x M4 L shaped hexagon key

You should check that screws and bolts are tight and secure before each ride.


DO NOT MOUNT TO CARBON FIBER SEAT POST.

If you have a carbon fibre seat post you must replace it with an aluminium or steel seat post.

1 Remove the Pin and bolt from receiver and slide the receiver out from the support arm. Keep the pin and bolt aside.



2 Unscrew the 4 x M6 hexagon from the receiver.



3 Mount the receiver onto your bicycle seat pole. Ensure that there is at least 4.5cm seat pole exposed.



4 Install the receiver as high up the seat pole as possible. Tighten the 4 M6 screws with washers using the hexagon key.



5 Assemble the seat by raising the paw deck and securing the center stand with the blue labelled M4 screws and washers.



6 Flip your Buddyrider seat upside and align the support arm's holes with the Buddyrider seat's holes. Position the Buddyrider seat on the support arm as far forward as possible without causing any interference with the steering post or handlebars of the bicycle.



7 Tighten the remaining 4 red labelled screws using the hexagon key.



8 Remove the safety harness from the packaging and secure it to the Buddyrider's front and back straps. Clips will be in front and behind the neck.



9 Ensure that the strap is secure and adjusted properly. It should **NOT** come off easily. This is to ensure the safety of pet.



10 Slide the Buddyrider into the receiver and secure it with the pin and bolt. You are ready for ride.
